

Malus 'Molazam' (Zone 4)

Molten Lava Crabapple

A wide spreading weeper that gets its name from its autumn appearance when its branches seem to flow with bright red fruit.

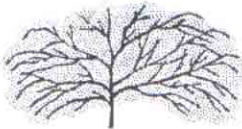

Malus 'Parrisi' (Zone 5)

Pink Princess™ Crab

A pink flowered, red leaf form of Sargent Crab. A naturally dwarf tree with all the desirable features of Sargent, but in a new color.

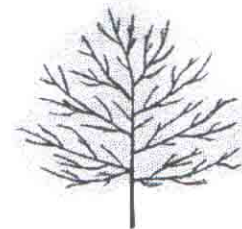

Malus 'Prairifire' (Zone 4)

Prairifire Crab

One of the best red leafed crabs. Attractive reddish bark.



Height: 20' **Spread:** 20' • **Shape:** Upright, spreading, rounded
Foliage: Purple, becoming reddish green
Flowers: Bright pinkish red • **Fruit:** Dark red, 3/8" - 1/2"
Disease Resistance: **Scab:** Excellent,
Cedar apple rust: Excellent, **Mildew:** Excellent,
Fireblight: Excellent

Malus 'Red Jade' (Zone 3)

Red Jade Crab

Red Jade has an elegant habit with long, graceful slender weeping branches. Its bright red fruit is persistent into winter.



Height: 10' **Spread:** 15' • **Shape:** Weeping, graceful
Foliage: Glossy green • **Flowers:** Deep pink bud, white flower
Fruit: Glossy red, 1/2", abundant
Disease Resistance: **Scab:** Poor, **Cedar apple rust:** Excellent
Mildew: Fair, **Fireblight:** Fair

Malus 'Red Jade' Contorta
Contorted Red Jade Crab

Malus 'Jewelcole' P.P. No. 3267 (Zone 4)

Red Jewel Crab

One of the most persistent fruit of any crab. Bright red berries will last until spring in mild winter areas.



Height: 15' **Spread:** 12' • **Shape:** Upright, pyramidal
Foliage: Green • **Flowers:** White • **Fruit:** Red, 1/2"
Disease Resistance: **Scab:** Good, **Cedar apple rust:** Excellent,
Mildew: Good, **Fireblight:** Fair

Malus 'Robinson' (Zone 4)

Robinson Crab

The fastest growing crabapple. It becomes established and makes an impact in the landscape quickly. Matures at normal crab size.

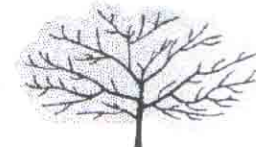


Height: 25' **Spread:** 25' • **Shape:** Upright, spreading, rounded
Foliage: Bronze green • **Flowers:** Deep pink • **Fruit:** Red, 3/8"
Disease resistance: **Scab:** Good, **Cedar apple rust:** Excellent
Mildew: Excellent, **Fireblight:** Excellent

Malus sargentii (Zone 5)

Sargent Crab

A natural dwarf with horizontal spreading branches. Outstanding when planted in groups. Grown on EMLA III understock which does not sucker readily.

Foliage: Green • **Flowers:** White • **Fruit:** Red, 1/4" persistent
Disease Resistance: **Scab:** Excellent
Cedar apple rust: Excellent, **Mildew:** Excellent,
Fireblight: Excellent

Malus sargentii (Zone 5)
Multi-Stem Sargent Crab

Malus sargentii 'Tina' (Zone 4)

Sargent Tina Crab

Grown as a 40" top graft, this smallest of all crabs features a compact, rounded head. Flowers, fruit, and leaves are all quite small.



Height: 5' **Spread:** 6' • **Shape:** Small rounded
Foliage: Medium green • **Flowers:** White • **Fruit:** Bright red, 1/4"
Disease Resistance: Excellent
