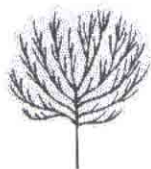


*Prunus x cistena* (Zone 3)  
**Cistena Plum - Top Graft**

Tree form of this outstanding plum grafted onto a 5' standard. Flowers are very fragrant in spring.



**Height:** 8' • **Shape:** Rounded • **Foliage:** Purple red  
**Flowers:** Very light pink

*Prunus x cistena 'Schmidtcois'* P.P. No. 5003 (Zone 2)  
**Big Cis Plum**

Discovered as a sport of Cistena, Big Cis exhibits growth rate twice as rapid. Shares same beautiful pink flowers of parent.



**Height:** 14' **Spread:** 12' • **Shape:** Rounded, dense  
**Foliage:** Purple • **Flowers:** Light pink, very fragrant

**Pyrus** (Flowering Pear)

*Pyrus calleryana 'Aristocrat'* P.P. No. 3193 (Zone 4)  
**Aristocrat Pear**

Aristocrat has an open, informal appearance. Branch angles are wider than other pears, thus more resistant to storm damage.



**Height:** 40' **Spread:** 28' • **Shape:** Pyramidal, with open, spreading branches • **Foliage:** Narrow, dark green, glossy  
**Fall Color:** Deep red • **Flowers:** White

*Pyrus calleryana 'Glen's Form'* (Zone 4)  
**Chanticleer Pear**

This selection is noted for better blooming and more even branching. Narrow, pyramidal in shape.



**Height:** 40' **Spread:** 15' • **Shape:** Upright, narrowly pyramidal  
**Foliage:** Green, glossy • **Flowers:** White, in clusters  
**Fall Color:** Reddish

*Pyrus calleryana 'Holmford'* (Zone 5)  
**New Bradford Pear**

Similar to Bradford Pear, but with better branch angles making it less susceptible to storm damage. Very disease resistant.



**Height:** 35' **Spread:** 30' • **Shape:** Broad, rounded  
**Foliage:** Dark green, glossy • **Flowers:** White  
**Fall Color:** Yellow to orange-red

*Pyrus calleryana 'Trinity'* P.P. No. 4530 (Zone 5)  
**Trinity Pear**

A slightly smaller pear with glossy green foliage and striking orange-red fall color.



**Height:** 30' **Spread:** 25' • **Shape:** Broadly oval to round  
**Foliage:** Glossy green • **Flower:** White • **Fall Color:** Orange-red

**Quercus** (Oak)

*Quercus acutissima* (Zone 5)  
**Sawtooth Oak**

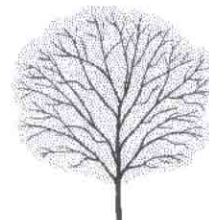
A fast growing, spreading oak well adapted to the summer heat of the south. It has outstanding summer foliage: very glossy and sharply serrated, which gives it a clean, crisp appearance.



**Height:** 40' **Spread:** 40' • **Shape:** Rounded  
**Foliage:** Dark green, glossy • **Fall Color:** Yellow

*Quercus alba* (Zone 4)  
**White Oak**

A slow-growing rounded oak with horizontal open-branch system. Reaches 25' in 10-20 years.



**Height:** 45' **Spread:** 45' • **Shape:** Rounded  
**Foliage:** Medium green, fine textured • **Fall Color:** Purplish red
