

Caragana (Siberian Pea)

CARAGANA arborescens 'Pendula' (Zone 2) Siberian Weeping Peashrub

A very cold hardy plant, able to withstand some of the most difficult sites. Well adapted to drought and poor or alkaline soil. Attractive spring flowers and summer foliage.



Height: 15' **Spread:** 15' • **Shape:** Weeping
Foliage: Pinnately compound, bright medium green
Flowers: Small, bright yellow • **Fall Color:** Yellowish

CARAGANA arborescens 'Walker' (Zone 2) Walker Weeping Peashrub

The finely cut weeping foliage gives a fern-like appearance. Grown on a 3' std, it makes an outstanding accent plant.



Height: 8' **Spread:** 8' • **Shape:** Weeping
Foliage: Green/fern-like • **Fall Color:** Yellowish
Flower: Small bright yellow

Carpinus (Hornbeam)

Carpinus betulus 'Fastigiata' (Zone 5) Pyramidal European Hornbeam

This medium sized tree is very symmetrical and presents a formal appearance. It is heat and drought resistant, and seems to be relatively free of disease and pest problems.



Height: 35' **Spread:** 25' • **Shape:** Dense compact, narrow when young, becoming oval • **Foliage:** Dark green
Fall Color: Yellow

Carpinus betulus 'Frans Fontaine' (Zone 5) Frans Fontaine Columnar Hornbeam

This European selection is more columnar than other varieties. Its compact narrow form does not tend to broaden at the base with age. Excellent for narrow areas.



Height: 35' **Spread:** 15' • **Shape:** Narrow Columnar
Foliage: Dark green • **Fall Color:** Yellow

Carpinus betulus Globosa (Zone 5) Globosa Hornbeam

A slow growing tree with a rounded, dense growth habit. Leaves are prominently produced at the ends of the branches. 4' std.



Height: 20' **Spread:** 10-15' • **Shape:** Rounded • **Foliage:** Green
Fall Color: Yellow

Carpinus caroliniana (Zone 4) American Hornbeam syn Blue Beech

A slow grower with a dense, rounded form. Features a smooth sinuous bluish-gray bark.



Height: 25' **Spread:** 20' • **Shape:** Oval
Foliage: Dark green • **Fall Color:** Yellow to bright orange-red

Cercis (Redbud)

CERCIS canadensis (Zone 4) Eastern Redbud

The profuse flowers that bloom in April or May before the leaves develop make this a spring favorite.



Height: 25' **Spread:** 30' • **Shape:** Ascending then spreading
Foliage: Medium green • **Fall Color:** Yellow
Flowers: Reddish purple in bud, rosy-pink when open

CERCIS canadensis - Multi-Stem Multi-Stem Eastern Redbud

CERCIS canadensis 'Forest Pansy' (Zone 5) Forest Pansy Redbud

A red-leaved selection of Eastern Redbud features showy pink-lavender blossoms in spring.



Height: 20' **Spread:** 25' • **Shape:** Upright spreading, rounded
Foliage: Deep purple • **Fall Color:** Yellow orange
Flowers: Deep rose-lavender
